Riel Roussopoulos is an entrepreneur in the truest sense of the word. As someone with a very solid understanding of computers and a good instinct for business, Riel has always been on the bleeding edge of the early adopter crowd.

Riel was the founder of **undernet.*** Services Ltd., a now defunct entertainment company that was a key player in developing Vancouver's rave scene throughout the '90's. By combining a proprietary magnetic stripe card based ticketing and membership system that he developed, with some innovative and aggressive city lobbying tactics, Riel and his partners were instrumental in bringing about the current legal structure to holding all night parties in Vancouver.

As a DJ and Music Producer, DJ Riel has had the opportunity of playing at some of the west coasts best known events and with some of the worlds best DJ's. Playing a unique mix of sexy house and progressive dance music, Riel is a guaranteed crowd pleaser, be it at a 100 person club night or a 10,000 person outdoor festival.

Other notable career highlights include producing the opening sequence for the second season of the hit teen television series MADISON, broadcast on CanWest Global. As well as being the Presentation Consultant to the HR MacMillan Planetarium during it's \$8.8 Million fund raising and subsequent transformation into the Pacific Space Centre.

Riel has also been responsible for producing over 100 youth oriented, live music events and is dedicated to producing events in safe, legal and peaceful environments for people of all ages to gather, communicate, have fun and dance regardless of gender or race.

Most recently Riel grew his love of Christmas lighting into a successful holiday business with international reach. He started weputuplights.com, a holiday lighting company which now serves over 100 clients in 3 cities. The business did over \$100,000 in business over a 3 month period, and has doubled every year for 3 years, with no sign of slowing down.
